Thank you for your interest in the EMT-Basic class at Clackamas Community College. This form will guide your entry into the program. **Please read it carefully.**

The EMT-Basic course consists of two classes, EMT-101 and EMT-102. The classes must be taken sequentially. Each class is 77 hours and EMT-102 has a 16 hour clinical component. This adds up to approximately 170 total hours (88 lecture, 66 lab, and 16 clinical hours).

<sup>1</sup> EMT's must be 18 years of age to be certified by the state of Oregon. *Required documentation: write in your date-of-birth and initial. Proof of age must be presented upon request.*

<sup>2</sup> Student candidate identifies name, location and year of graduation/completion. *Required documentation: write in school and year of graduation, initial. Proof must be presented upon request.*

<sup>3</sup> American Heart Association Healthcare Provider Basic Life Support CPR with pediatric and AED components or equivalent. Certifications from other organizations may require a letter from the certifying organization detailing equivalency. **AHA CPR classes are offered frequently at CCC; please check the schedule of classes to find out when the next CPR course is offered.** *Best proof – front/back copy of current AHA Healthcare Provider CPR card.*

<sup>4</sup> Required inoculations are determined by Clackamas Community College clinical affiliates and include, but are not limited to: TB Exam (within 12 months), Hepatitis B immunization series started, MMR (measles immunity), Tetanus (within 10 years), Influenza (as available), and Chickenpox (Varicella). *Required documentation: recent copy of healthcare provider signature on documentation of inoculations. (Estimated cost is for all required inoculations, and may be less for individual students.)*

<sup>5</sup> Placement testing is available through the CCC Testing Center (x2269). Test must be current within one year of start of program. Place into WR-121; place into MTH-65; place into RD-115. *Best proof – printout of test results from CCC's Testing Center or unofficial transcripts showing equivalent course completion.*

<sup>6</sup> All EMT students will need to provide a completed fingerprint card and a check for \$67.50 (made out to "Oregon State Police") for the purposes of criminal history background check. Card and check are submitted with picture ID verification to the department secretary, prior to registration. Attach a 2x2 photo, similar to a passport photo.

<sup>7</sup> Signature must be of an authorized representative of the EMT program.

NOTE: *A urine drug screen will be required prior to your clinical rotation in 2<sup>nd</sup> term. Estimated cost \$ 34.00.*
