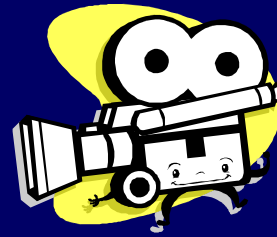


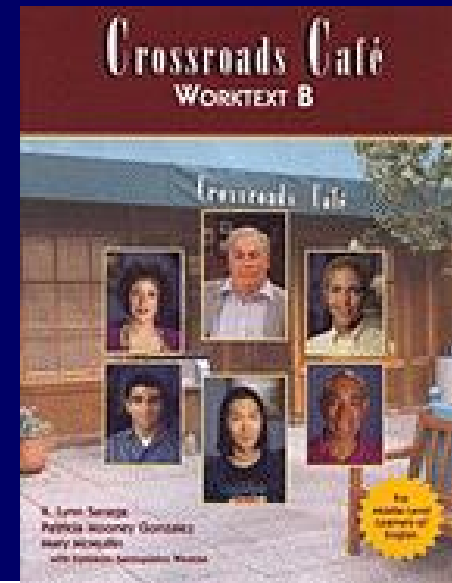

Electives Classes
